Plenitude On The Road Srl ensures the health and safety of its employees, the public, contractors, and Customers, as well as the protection of the environment



- by contributing to achieving **environmental sustainability** goals by investing resources in the growth of electric mobility;

- **monitoring performance to manage health, safety, and environmental aspects** through control and review systems with a view to continuous improvement, measuring performance against specific KPIs.
